Wi-Power High-Speed Internet and Digital Phone Service Now Available in Deming, NM

DEMING, NM—May 19, 2010—TransWorld Network Corp. (TWN), in partnership with AZNEX Cooperative Services is pleased to announce that Wi-Power® High-Speed Internet service is now available in Deming, New Mexico.

Wi-Power is high-speed, wireless Internet access designed for customers in areas that are typically underserved by communication services. Almost 8,000 customers throughout Arizona and New Mexico currently subscribe to Wi-Power High-Speed Internet and Digital Phone through TWN and AZNEX Cooperative Services. Deming is the latest service deployment area for the company whose New Mexico expansion plans also include Las Cruces and Truth or Consequences later this year.

Wi-Power users receive a high-speed connection to the Internet with available download speeds up to 5.0 Mbps for residential customers. Wi-Power users connect to the Internet using an antenna and a modem located at their business or residence. The antenna, mounted outside of the home or business, sends a wireless signal to TWN's equipment located nearby. Wi-Power does not require satellite systems, a cable connection or even local phone service. Digital Phone service, also known as VoIP is also available through AZNEX Cooperative Services. Digital Phone service allows customers to make and receive unlimited local and long distance calls using their Internet connection instead of a

traditional phone line. Wi-Power Internet and Digital Phone services are available separately or can be bundled for less than \$60.00 per month. "In the current economy, consumers are constantly seeking ways to save money. Our bundled Internet and Phone service offering can save customers between \$40 and \$50 each month – that's a significant dollar amount that can be put toward other rising household expenses." states Ami Rodriguez.
