AZNEX Cooperative Services and TWN Form Partnership to Expand High-Speed Internet Program

DUNCAN, AZ/TAMPA, FL—June 17, 2008—Duncan Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. (DVEC) and its wholly owned subsidiary, AZNEX Cooperative Services, have entered into a partnership agreement with TransWorld Network, Corp. (TWN) to provide high-speed Internet access to customers in Arizona and New Mexico.

The Internet service, provided by TWN, is called Wi-Power®. Wi-Power is high-speed wireless Internet access designed to serve customers throughout Southeastern Arizona, as well as parts of Southwestern New Mexico. Almost 2,000 customers currently have high-speed Internet access through AZNEX and TWN will work with AZNEX to migrate these customers to TWN's Wi-Power network facilities. As a result, consumers will receive improved system performance and more service options. Jack Shilling, CEO of DVEC expressed, "This partnership is a great opportunity for AZNEX to bring higher speeds and 24 hour technical support to its subscribers. We look forward to TWN bringing additional value to our Internet community." Colin Wood, CEO of TWN stated, "Wi-Power will improve the broadband experience for AZNEX customers. TWN is pleased to be partnering with AZNEX to bring additional service value to consumers,"

Wi-Power users receive a high-speed connection to the Internet with available download speeds starting at 384 Kbps going up to 1.5 Mbps for residential customers. Wi-Power users connect to the Internet using an antenna and a modem located at their business or residence that sends a wireless signal to TWN's equipment located nearby. Wi-Power does not require satellite systems, a cable connection or even local phone service. TWN will also provide installation, billing and customer service support to AZNEX Internet customers.

Duncan Valley Electric Cooperative (DVEC) is a member-owned electric distribution cooperative. Incorporated in 1947, DVEC provides electric power to approximately 2,500 homes, farms, ranches, schools and businesses in southern Greenlee County in Arizona, as well as parts of Grant and Hidalgo Counties in New Mexico.
