**TRICO Electric Cooperative Partners with TransWorld Network, Corp. to
offer Wireless Broadband Internet to Consumers**

MARANA, AZ/TAMPA, FL — January 8, 2007 — TRICO Electric Cooperative, Inc. has entered into a partnership agreement with TransWorld Network, Corp. (TWN) to provide TRICO members with high speed fixed wireless broadband Internet access.

The Internet service provided by TWN, called Wi-Power®, is secure, high-speed wireless access and the next generation of connectivity for residential and business customers. Wi-Power provides a true high-speed wireless connection to the Internet and is designed to reach areas currently underserved by communication providers. Customers are able to connect to the Internet using an antenna and a modem located at their business or residence. Wi-Power does not require satellite systems, a cable connection, or even local phone service. “Consumers are seeking broadband services to fulfill business and personal needs. The challenges of providing members with affordable, reliable broadband services in TRICO’s service area will be met by combining access initiatives which TRICO has undertaken along with TWN’s technical and service expertise” Colin Wood, CEO of TWN stated.

TRICO currently offers dial-up Internet access and long distance service through TWN. The companies will work together to introduce existing customers to the new high-speed offering as well as attract new customers to the service through joint marketing efforts. Initially, Wi-Power will service the immediate Marana area, but will be available to adjacent communities as the network expands. TransWorld Network will also provide billing and customer service support to TRICO Internet and long distance customers. “TRICO serves its fast growing base of members with reliable affordable electric power and certain value added services. We are

pleased to be able to work with TWN to extend broadband services to our members as well as consumers adjacent to our service territory” Marsha Johnson, Manager, Marketing & Services of TRICO stated.
